Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your support today. It has been truly lovely to see the children again and they have been fantastic! Please remember when you are dropping off and picking up your child to adhere to social distancing rules particularly remaining at 2m apart wherever possible. I completely understand if you want to talk after you have dropped your child off but please could you not congregate outside school. There are many members of our school community who are living with extremely vulnerable family members and we need to ensure that the school is as safe as possible for them.

Drop off and pick up worked well apart from a few teething problems. Please note the timings for pick up. You will not be allowed on playground until your allotted time. The gates will be shut between slots to allow classes to get onto playground.

- 2.50 pm Afternoon nursery and Class 1 (Mrs Gunston) + siblings
- 2.55 pm Class 2 (Mrs Whitehill) + siblings
- 3.00 pm Class 3 (Mr Wilcox) and Class 4 (Mr Cumiskey)

Also, please do not come to the school office unless it is urgent; instead telephone or email please. If you do have to enter the building, please wear a face covering.

We are running Breakfast Club (7.45 – 8.40 am) and After school club (3.05- 5.45 pm) again. You can pay for this via Parent pay and contact the school office for a form. For Breakfast club you must leave your child at the school office and a member of staff will ensure that they go to the hall. For After School club a member of staff will bring your child to outside school. If there is no-one in the office please ring the school 01740 644374 and a member of the After school club will answer and bring your child to you.

We may need to adapt and change throughout the following weeks but I will aim to keep you updated as much as possible. Similarly, if you have any concerns or queries please just get in touch. It is still a period of anxiety and worry so please do not hesitate to contact me and I will try to help if at all possible.

One other piece of information to share with you. After a process of due diligence it has been decided that Prince Regent Street Trust will not merge with Extol; a letter from our CEO, Julia Armstrong, will follow soon.

Thank you for all your support; I am so happy to have our Wolviston 'family' back together again.
