Sun Safety

During these hotter, sunnier days staff across school are always extra vigilant regarding the safety of the children and their exposure to UV rays. We continue to encourage parents to apply sun screen to their child each morning, before school and welcome children wearing a lightweight sun hat. Sunglasses are not permitted in school, unless prescribed by medical professionals. In the event of extreme high temperatures, children will not be exposed to direct sunlight for more than twenty minutes. Drinking water is available to all, regular water intake is encouraged. We regularly speak to children regarding keeping 'sun safe'.
