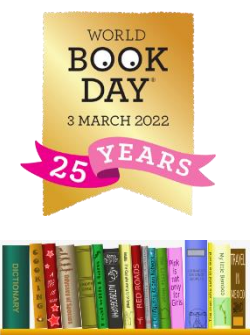
PARENT QUESTIONNAIRE

Our service provides structured care and support for your child and is led by qualified staff who know your child well.

To ensure we meet correct staff/pupil ratios we must keep an accurate track of attendance at each club.

Booking for next half term will open on Thursday 17th Feb at 5pm and will close on Friday 4th Mar at 5pm.

Unfortunately, bookings after this date may not be possible. Apologies for any inconvenience caused.

Bookings can only be made via the form and can no longer be made at the school office.

Where emergency wrap-around care is needed please contact the school, we will aim to meet requests for exceptional circumstances.

Due to staff/child ratios there are 25 places available for each club. Once filled, the option to book a place will be removed.
