Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2:30 - Phonics Information for Y1 Parents

We will introduce parents to our Floppy's Phonics scheme that we use to teach reading in Reception and Year 1. There will be opportunities to ask questions and find out more about how you can help your child with their reading.

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September - Welcome Assembly

We would like to invite all Class 2 parents and carers into school for a welcome assembly, where we will share the expectations of KS1 and answer any questions you may have.

Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September - Visit to Preston Park

We will be attending the Traditional Toys Workshop to discover how toys have changed over time. We will also be visiting the Victorian Street and Museum to understand how life and childhood has changed over time.

Curriculum

Topic

During the Autumn Term, our class topic is 'Childhood'. We will be learning about changes within living memory and exploring how life has changed with a focus on toys.

English

Throughout the Autumn Term, we will be exploring texts about feelings, night poems and learning how to write a story, acrostic poems and a diary.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning the importance of place value. We will then move onto addition and subtraction followed by shape.

Home Learning

Spelling Shed

Children will receive login details for Spelling Shed. They will be able to access games linked to the spelling patterns taught in school. This will be followed by a spelling test in school, Year 2 Monday and Year 1 Friday. Year 2 will receive their new spellings on a Monday and Year 1 on a Friday.

My Maths

Your child will receive a login for My Maths. We will set weekly tasks will be set for your child to complete every Friday.

*All login details can be found in your child's reading journal.*

Creative Homework

Each half term your child will be provided with a range of Creative Homework linked to our topic. Children will receive a Golden Certificate for completing six pieces, a Silver Certificate for four and Bronze for three.

Reading

It is incredibly important that your child reads regularly at home to develop their comprehension and fluency. We expect children to read 3x a week at home.
